Educating Arrows Home-school Cooperative LEAH is a Christian organization. Educating Arrows LEAH members are expected to exhibit conduct consistent with the teachings of Jesus Christ. Expectations of members include the following:

1. Families must be members of Educating Arrows LEAH and NYS LEAH.
2. Membership fees must be paid on time.
3. Members must read and agree to Educating Arrows Bylaws, Statement of Faith, and Code of Conduct.
4. Parent volunteers are essential to a successful program. One parent per family is required to volunteer 1 day per session.
5. Parents must fill out emergency contact forms and be available by phone during the drop off program.
6. All students are to be respectful to others and their teachers. Bullying and violence towards others will not be tolerated.
7. Members are asked to be on time and ready to learn.
8. Members must inform Leadership of any allergies their child/children have.
9. Any student who creates an unsafe environment may be asked to leave the program.

Children are asked to wear shoes appropriate for running and playing.

If your child needs medication during program, please make arrangements with the president or vice president.
